<u>Sealed Bids:</u> Houston County will accept sealed proposals from qualified bidders for the Intersection Improvements, Margie Drive @ Osigian Boulevard project at the Houston County Public Works Department, 2018 Kings Chapel Road, Perry, Georgia, until 10:00 am local time on Thursday, January 12, 2023. Upon expiration of time for receipt of bids, all bids will be opened and publicly read aloud. No bid may be withdrawn after the closing time for the receipt of bids for a period of sixty (60) calendar days after bid opening date.

Qualified Bidder: a qualified bidder shall be an interested party who attended the mandatory pre-bid conference which was held Thursday, November 3, 2022, at the Houston County Public Works Department, 2018 Kings Chapel Road in Perry, Georgia. A qualified bidder must hold a current Georgia Department of Transportation Certificate of Qualification. A copy of the Certificate of Qualification must be included in the bid package. A qualified bidder must affix their E-Verify number and their Georgia Utility Contractor License Number, to the outside of the bid envelope.

Bonds: All bids must be accompanied by a Bid Bond in the amount not less than ten percent (10%) of the Total Base Bid. Performance and Payment Bond, each in the amount of one hundred percent (100%) of the total contract amount, will be required of the successful bidder. Bonds must be written by an acceptable Surety Company licensed to do business in the State of Georgia and listed in the Department of Treasury, Circular 570, latest edition.

Project Description: The proposed construction consists of furnishing all materials and equipment and performing all labor necessary to complete the Intersection Improvements, Margie Drive @ Osigian Blvd. (project roadway length is 0.16 miles). Work includes grading, curbing, and striping. All work will be in accordance with the Georgia Department of Transportation standard specifications and supplemental specifications (latest edition), the Georgia Manual for Erosion and Sediment Control (latest edition), and Houston County.

<u>Additional Pertinent Information:</u> All original contract documents, plans, and pre bid conference documentation are to be considered as part of this re-bid. Contractor shall obtain from the Engineer and use the new Bid Proposal in their bid submittal.
