WHEREAS, J & B Capital Group, LLC, hereinafter referred to as "Applicant", submitted an Abandonment of County Easement/Right-of-Way Request Form on behalf of the property owners of the property located at 235 Mossy Lake Road, Perry, Georgia, 31069, hereinafter referred to as the "Property"; and

WHEREAS, the Applicant is requesting the abandonment of any and all interest the County may have in a 20' drainage easement traversing the Property. The 20' drainage easement is designated as "20' Existing Drainage Easement (To Be Abandoned)" on a plan prepared by Brian Hill Braun November 10, 2023. Said plan is attached hereto as Exhibit "A"; and

WHEREAS, it is agreed that the drainage easement will be relocated and remain on the Property. The relocated drainage easement will follow the southern and eastern property lines as designated on the plan attached hereto as Exhibit "A"; and

WHEREAS, the following departments of Houston County have reviewed and approved the requests submitted by the Applicant: Inspections/P&Z, Environmental Health, Engineering, Roads & Bridges, Water, Fire/E911, and County Attorney; and


WHEREAS, the Houston County Board of Commissioners have the authority to abandon any and all interest that Houston County may have in the drainage easement.


