
JUDICIAL EMERGENCY ORDER (Amended)

Re: Coronavirus/COVID-19 Outbreak

NOTICE: Pursuant to the March 14, 2020 Order of the Supreme Court of Georgia declaring a Statewide Judicial Emergency due to the Coronavirus/COVID-19 outbreak, the Magistrate Court of Houston County has hereby suspended ALL civil matters and criminal pre-warrant application proceedings and hearings until April 13, 2020, or until further notice. New civil cases may be filed, but no hearings or trials will be scheduled or heard during this period.

In addition, the Houston County Sheriff's Department is hereby ordered to suspend the execution all writs of possession (Eviction set-outs) issued by this Court until April 13, 2020, or until further notice of this Court or the Supreme Court of Georgia.
