ORDER REOPENING THE HOUSTON SUPERIOR COURT CLERK'S OFFICE

On July 22, 2020, an Order closing the Houston Superior Court Clerk's Office was issued by the Court due to an active case of COVID-19 in that office and the exposure of a number of deputy clerks to that person. As more than two weeks have now passed since the exposure and the at risk personnel have been tested with negative results, the Court finds it appropriate to reopen all divisions of the Clerk's Office. Therefore, the Order of July 22, 2020 will expire at 8:30am on Wednesday August 5, 2020 and the Houston Superior Court Clerk's Office will be open to the public at that time. All local and state guidelines now in place are to be followed by all personnel and anyone entering the Clerk's Office to conduct business.
